

ADVANCE ART COURSE

Duration: 8 Months (192 Hrs.)

The Advance Art Course is designed for students who want to master techniques, explore multiple mediums, and develop their own artistic style. This course focuses on realism, expressive painting, advanced portraiture, landscapes, and professional portfolio development, including oil painting techniques.

Mediums Covered: Advanced Pencil & Charcoal | Colour Pencils (Realism & Detailing) | Soft Pastels
Watercolours (Professional techniques) | Acrylic Painting | Oil Painting | Mixed Media Exploration

Advanced Drawing & Composition

- > Advanced shading methods and depth creation
- > Complex still life compositions
- > Understanding balance, contrast, and focal points

Portrait Drawing

- > Detailed facial anatomy and skull structure
- > Accurate facial proportions
- > Skin texture and realistic hair rendering
- > Light direction and shadow impact
- > Realistic portrait in pencil or charcoal

Colour Portrait Techniques

- > Advanced colour theory for skin tones
- > Colour pencil realism techniques
- > Expression and mood creation in portraits

Landscape & Nature Painting

- > Study of natural elements (trees, skies, clouds, water, rocks)
- > Atmospheric perspective
- > Mood creation through color harmony
- > Landscape painting in watercolor and acrylic

Acrylic & Still Life Painting

- > Complex still life arrangements
- > Reflective and transparent surfaces in Still Life
- > Brush techniques and layering
- > Acrylic painting with realistic and expressive approaches

Oil Painting Techniques

- > Introduction to oil painting materials and safety
- > Understanding oil mediums and drying times
- > Underpainting and layering techniques
- > Colour blending and soft transitions
- > Still life or portrait painting in oils

Figure Drawing & Creative Exploration

- > Human body proportions and anatomy
- > Gesture drawing and movement
- > Fabric folds and dynamic poses
- > Mixed media experiments
- > Developing a personal artistic style

Portfolio Development & Final Projects

- > Concept planning and artwork selection
- > Creation of 2–3 finished artworks in chosen mediums
- > Individual feedback and refinement
- > Portfolio presentation guidance
